SOUTHWEST FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT REPORTS MARCH TRAFFIC

FORT MYERS, Fla. (April 29, 2008) – During the month of March, 1,030,151 passengers traveled through the airport. This is only the third time in the 25-year history of Southwest Florida International Airport that more than 1 million travelers have been accommodated in a single month.

The traffic leader for the month of March was AirTran with 144,393 passengers traveling to and from Fort Myers. Rounding out the top five airlines were JetBlue (119,328), Delta (112,346), Northwest (95,442) and US Airways (94,457).

At Southwest Florida International Airport, there were 11,074 aircraft movements (takeoffs and landings) recorded, a slight decrease of 0.55 percent from last March. Page Field General Aviation Airport saw 6,815 movements. In addition, over 3 million pounds of air freight moved through Southwest Florida International Airport in March 2008.

Southwest Florida International Airport served more than 8 million passengers in 2007 and is one of the top 50 busiest U.S. airports. No ad valorem (property) taxes are used for airport operation or construction. For more information, log onto www.flylcpa.com.
