SOUTHWEST FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT REPORTS MAY TRAFFIC

FORT MYERS, Fla. (June 26, 2008) – During May, more than 575,000 passengers traveled through Southwest Florida International Airport, a decrease of 4.6 percent compared to May 2007. Year-to-date, passenger traffic is down nearly 4.4 percent over the same period last year.

The traffic leader in May was Delta with 80,114 passengers traveling to and from Fort Myers. Rounding out the top five airlines were Air Tran (69,961), Southwest (69,689), US Airways (63,068) and Continental (56,493).

At Southwest Florida International Airport, 6,778 aircraft movements (takeoffs and landings) were recorded, a slight decrease of 0.72 percent over May 2007. Page Field General Aviation Airport saw 6,761 movements, a 13 percent increase over May 2007. In addition, nearly 2.7 million pounds of air freight moved through both airports in May 2008.

Southwest Florida International Airport served more than 8 million passengers in 2007 and is one of the top 50 busiest U.S. airports. No ad valorem (property) taxes are used for airport operation or construction. For more information, log onto www.flylcpa.com.
