LEE COUNTY PORT AUTHORITY EMPLOYEE'S PHOTOGRAPHY WORK FEATURED IN *AIRPORT MAGAZINE*

FORT MYERS, Fla. (Feb. 13, 2009) – Angie Chestnut, maintenance resources supervisor for the Lee County Port Authority, recently received national recognition for her photographic work. Two of her photos, a P-51D Mustang at Page Field General Aviation Airport and Air Force One at Southwest Florida International Airport, were featured in the December/January 2009 issue of American Association of Airport Executives' Airport Magazine.

Airport Magazine announced a contest calling for the best aviation-related feature photography in their April/May issue. The contest was judged by the magazine's Editorial Advisory Board. Chestnut submitted her images and two were selected as winning photographs and featured in the magazine.
